

IBT Group and Alfridomsa reaffirms its commitment to environmental rescue of Constance

SANTO DOMINGO (Rep. Dominicana) - Companies Alfridomsa and IBT Group have reaffirmed their commitment to the environmental rescue of Constance, with another entire day of planting trees in an area of Tireo affected by a recent fire.

Employees of the companies coordinated this laborious day with the support of technicians from the Ministry of Environment and members of the Sixth Battalion of Cazadores General Gregorio Luperon which operates in Constance.

Gina Victoriano, the Managing Director of both companies, greatly appreciated the availability of company employees, Ministry of Environment employees and members of the Army who participated in the tree planting operation.

He recalled that forests in Tireo are a key element in preserving waterstreams and rivers that feed the Pinalito dam, which produces electricity for the national system and also serves its waters to the province Monsignor Nouel, in the productive region of Cibao.

The forestry initiative on Saturday adds to the efforts of civil society and the authorities and other companies become aware of environmental issues which are reflected in the recent drought that has impacted Constanza for more than two years.

In recent years IBT Group and the company Alfridomsa have planted more than 30,000 trees of different species, in diverse areas of the productive municipality of Constanza.

With these reforestation efforts, both companies reaffirm the commitment to preserving the environment as a legacy that all citizens must pass on to future generations.
